GUARDING AGAINST TERRORISM

WHAT YOU CAN DO

BE VIGILANT

- Be attentive to activities or behaviour within your community that may be indicators of radicalization. Be aware of
 - People who sympathise with terrorists and their causes
 - People who try to influence others to support terrorism and/or participate in terrorist activity
 - People who display insignia or symbols in support of terrorist groups
- Be alert to tell-tale indicators of suspicious or malicious intent

Appearance (of person)

- Person who acts to hide his identity, purpose of visit, or objects on his body
- Anyone loitering for an extended period of time, sometimes doing video recording of the surroundings
- Any bodily cues of anxiety, e.g. sweating profusely

Belongings

- Any item left unattended in public areas, or abandoned in ways that seem out of place
- Parcels or mail that require an excessive usage of adhesive tape
- Parcels or mail with strange odours like almond or marzipan

Cars

- Any vehicle being driven around an area repeatedly including on different occasions
- Any vehicle abandoned abruptly by drivers at the roadside or next to buildings
- Any overly-weighted vehicles with sunken boots or bottoms
- Any vehicle with signs of tampering
- Do not approach the suspicious persons or touch the suspicious items. Inform the security officer or call the Police at `999' for urgent Police assistance.

BE PREPARED

In The Rare Event Of A FIREARMS Or WEAPONS Attack

RUN · HIDE · TELL



- RUN when it is safe to do so
- Move quickly and quietly, stay out of view of the attackers
- · Leave your belongings behind
- Insist others leave with you



- HIDE if you can't run
- Find cover and stay out of sight
- Lock yourself in but do not get trapped
- Stay quiet and switch your phone to silent mode



- TELL the police when it is safe to do so(Tel: 999)
- SMS 71999 if it is not safe to call. Give your location and information about the attackers
- You can also send more information through i-Witness on the Police@SG application
- Follow the instructions of the police and do not make any sudden movements

防范恐怖主义须知

保持警惕

- 留意社区里是否有激进化的活动或行为。留意
 - 同情恐怖主义者及其主张的人
 - 试图影响他人支持恐怖主义及/或参与恐怖活动的人
 - 。 展示恐怖主义组织徽章或标志以示支持 的人
- 留意有恶意或可疑意图的明显迹象

Appearance(样貌)

- 试图隐瞒身份、到访目的或所携物品
- 长时间徘徊并对周遭环境进行视频录像的人
- 身体出现焦虑的迹象,例如:不断冒汗

Belongings (物品)

- 在公共地方无人看管/认领,显得与周遭环境 不相称的物件
- 使用大量胶黏带的包裹或邮件
- 有特殊气味譬如杏仁味的包裹或邮件

Car (车辆)

- 在不同时间重复在一个地区兜转的车辆
- 仓促停在路旁或建筑物旁然后司机不知所踪的车辆
- 行李厢或车尾下沉,看来超重的车辆
- 有被篡改迹象的车辆
- 别与可疑人物直接接触或触碰可疑物品。通知保安人员或马上拨999通知警方寻求紧急救援。

作好准备

若不幸遇见了罕见的枪击或武器袭击事件

逃离、躲藏、通报



情况安全时才逃离

- 静悄悄地迅速逃离,远离袭击者的视 线范围
- 留下你的个人物品
- 坚持其他人与你一起离开



如果无法逃离就躲藏

- · 找地方掩护,避开袭击者视线
- 把自己锁起来但别被困在里面
- 别发出声音并把手机调至静音模式



情况安全时才通知警方(拨 999)

- 若情况危急,无法拨电报警,请发简讯至71999向有关当局通报你的位置并提供袭击者的资料
- 你也可通过 Police@SG应用程序的 i-Witness,提供更多相关讯息给警方
- 遵守警察的指示,切勿忽然乱动
