

LUCKY DRAW SCAMS

Travellers have been approached in public places with invitations to participate in lucky draws offering attractive prizes and cash.



DON'T BECOME THE NEXT VICTIM.

- Be wary of “get-rich-quick” offers. If it sounds too good to be true, it is probably a scam.
- Do not make any payments for lucky draw ‘prizes’.
- Do not accept car rides from strangers even if they offer you a lift back to your home country.

LOVE SCAMS

Scammers would use social networks or dating sites to trick victims using psychological tricks and gifts. Many victims have succumbed to the scammers’ love spells. Once the victim is in love, scammers would ask for money.



DON'T BECOME THE NEXT VICTIM.

- Exercise caution when dealing with unknown persons “befriended” through the Internet.
- Never put yourself in a vulnerable position or give personal details when interacting with other internet users.
- Avoid going overseas alone with persons whom you know through the Internet.
- Report to the administrators of the dating site or social network if you suspect that you are targeted.
- Inform the Police immediately if anyone attempts to extort money from you.

DON'T FALL PREY TO CHEATING SCAMS

Jenayah Penipuan

If you are a victim of such scams, you should immediately cease contact with the scammers and make a police report at the nearest Police Station.

PENIPUAN CABUTAN BERTUAH

Biasanya pelancong didekati dan dipujuk untuk menyertai cabutan bertuah yang menawarkan wang tunai dan hadiah-hadiah menarik.



ELAK DARIPADA MENJADI MANGSA

- Jangan terpedaya dengan tawaran skim-cepat-kaya. Tawaran yang menjanjikan pulangan yang tidak munasabah mungkin adalah satu penipuan.
- Jangan membuat sebarang bayaran untuk menebus hadiah cabutan bertuah.
- Jangan terima sebarang pelawaan menaiki pengangkutan persendirian daripada orang yang tidak dikenali walaupun untuk menghantar pulang ke negara anda.

CINTA PALSU

Para penipu ini juga telah menggunakan jaringan sosial atau laman cari jodoh (*dating sites*) untuk memperdaya mangsa melalui permainan psikologi, penggunaan kata-kata yang manis serta pemberian hadiah. Ramai mangsa telah terpesona dengan kata-kata cinta mereka. Sebaik sahaja anda jatuh cinta, penipu-penipu ini akan mula meminta wang.

ELAK DARIPADA MENJADI MANGSA

- Berwaspada apabila berurusan dengan orang yang tidak dikenali melalui internet.
- Jangan sesekali mendedahkan butir-butir peribadi anda apabila berinteraksi dengan pengguna internet yang lain dan meletakkan diri anda dalam keadaan berbahaya.
- Elakkan melancong bersendirian bersama orang yang anda kenali melalui internet.
- Laporkan kepada pentadbiran laman cari jodoh atau laman sosial berkenaan jika mengesyaki anda dijadikan sasaran.

Jika anda diperas ugut, segera laporkan kepada pihak polis.
