

LICENSING CONDITIONS FOR PRIVATE INVESTIGATION AGENCY LICENCE

- 1) The Licensee shall ensure that all private investigators employed by the Licensee are (a) certified by a registered medical practitioner¹ to be physically fit for work as private investigators before being deployed; and (b) are certified annually as such, if they are above the age of 60 years. The Licensee shall submit the relevant medical certificates to the Licensing Officer upon request.
- 2) The Licensee shall not employ any serving police officer (including members of the Volunteer Special Constabulary), any public servant or any other person who is employed by another employer if the employment is likely to result in a conflict of interest between any of his employers and the clients of the Licensee.
- 3) The Licensee shall ensure that all private investigators deployed for any assignments by the Licensee comply with all relevant laws in Singapore, in particular the Private Security Industry Act 2007, and the regulations and licensing conditions made thereunder.
- 4) Unless exempted by the Licensing Officer, the Licensee shall not deploy any person to work as a private investigator unless the person has obtained the relevant Workforce Skills Qualifications (“WSQ”) certifications, prescribed by the Licensing Officer at <https://www.police.gov.sg/Business-E-Services/Apply-for-Private-Investigation-Agency-Licence>.
- 5) Unless exempted by the Licensing Officer, the Licensee shall ensure that the WSQ certification requirements prescribed by the Licensing Officer at <https://www.police.gov.sg/Business-E-Services/Apply-for-Private-Investigation-Agency-Licence> are fulfilled.
- 6) The Licensee shall not be involved in any debt collection business and shall not authorise any employee to engage in debt collection.
