Licence holders for Explosive Precursors

Dear Licensee,

TRANSPORTATION OF EXPLOSIVE PRECURSORS

As a new year has begun, we wish to take the opportunity to remind our licensees that the transportation of Explosive Precursors (EPs) of net quantity 3 metric tonnes and above, must be carried out in compliance with the following licensing conditions:

- a) Transport Emergency Response Plan (TERP) must be submitted to the Singapore Civil Defence Force (SCDF) for approval. The approved TERP must be kept in the vehicle whenever EPs are transported;
- b) The approved vehicles must be fitted with tracking devices, immobilizers and have orange-coloured licence plates;
- c) The driver of a licensed vehicle must hold a valid HazMat Transport Driver Permit (HTDP) at all times when transporting EPs;
- d) Transporting of EPs may only be carried out between 7am to 7pm daily. If there is any deviation from this stipulated period, the licensee must obtain the prior, written approval of the Officer-in-Charge (OC) Arms & Explosives Division (AED), ASP Soh Ah Kiat; and
- e) All licensed vehicles transporting EPs must adhere to the approved routes set by SCDF.

3 As EPs pose a high security risk, they must be moved and transported in a safe and secure manner. Thus, please ensure you have the controls and measures required to transport EPs in compliance with the licensing conditions.
