## **Overview of Air Cargo Industry**

#### > Air Cargo Statistics

Year	Total Tonnage (estimated)	Passenger Aircraft	Freighter Aircraft
2015	1.85 million	68%	32%
2016	1.97 million	69%	31%
2017	2.13 million	71%	29%
2018	2.15 million	72%	28%
2019	0.65 million (up to April)	72%	28%






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## **Overview of Air Cargo Industry**





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- Implemented on 1 April 2008 to secure processes for handling, transporting and storing of cargo from the time cargo is accepted by cargo agent until cargo is lodged at the airfreight terminals
- Governed by Air Navigation (Regulated Air Cargo Agents) Regulations 2017 [AN(RACA)Regs 2017]
- A voluntary programme
  - Administered to air cargo agents
  - Applicable for exported air cargo only

#### Known Consignor Criteria - RCA

Consignors may qualify as known consignors in 2 ways:

- 1) <u>Industry-recognised security certifications</u>:
  - Singapore Customs Secure Trade Partnership (STP) / Secure Trade Partnership Plus (STP-Plus);
  - Transported Asset Protection Association (TAPA) Air Cargo Security Standards Level 1;
  - United States Customs-Trade Partnership Against Terrorism (C-TPAT) Tier 2 or Tier 3

#### <u>OR</u>

2) Commercial relationship

#### Known Consignor Criteria - RCA

Consignors may qualify as known consignors in 2 ways:

1) Industry-recognized security certifications:


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- 2) Commercial relationship:
  - Has consigned with the regulated air cargo agent
    - at least 3 times in the preceding 12 months with the 3<sup>rd</sup> shipment transacted in the preceding 6 months without incident; and
    - at least once every 6 months thereafter

#### Known Consignor Criteria - <u>AEC</u>

- Consignors may qualify as consignors with the AECs if:
  - a) Has Accounting and Corporate Regulatory Authority (ACRA) documentation to proof registration as a company, partnership or sole proprietorship
  - b) consignor's premise has been inspected by AEC and satisfied that there is no unusual activity therein

### **Regulation of Consignors**



- Consignors will be regulated in compliance with Annex 17 SARPs:
  - Annex 17 Standards 4.6.3 and 4.6.5 governing security supply chain for all cargo transported on board aircraft requires Contracting State's Appropriate Authority (AA) to adhere to two principles:
    - Must have oversight of entities in secure supply chain
    - Must have approved/revocation process for entities in secure supply chain
  - Phasing out of Consignors not subject to approval by Airport Police Division (Approval Authority) by Jun 2021
  - Implementation of Known Consignor Regime

#### **Known Consignor Criteria - AECs**

- Secure the processes for handling, transporting and storing of cargo from the time cargo originates from the consignor until the cargo is handed over to a cargo agent/freight forwarder
- Legislative powers will be provided for in a subsidiary legislation of Air Navigation Act
- A voluntary programme
  - Administered to consignors
  - Applicable for exported air cargo only



No registration cost



#### Key Thrust

- State involvement to regulate & define security standards
- Audit & inspection on the consignors
- All unknown cargo will be 100% screened
- Known cargo will be subjected to lower screening quantum





#### Who Will Be Affected?

- KCR will have impact on the following stakeholders:
  - Consignors of goods (individuals, consolidators, manufacturers as well as logistics companies)
  - ➤ 3<sup>rd</sup> party service providers
  - Cargo agents / freight forwarders
  - Airfreight Terminal Operators / AECs

#### Main Components

- Known Consignor Regime (KCR) implementation covers the following areas:
  - ✓ Legislation (required to implement KCR)
  - ✓ Registration
  - Security Programme / Industry-Recognised Security Certifications
  - ✓ Audit & Inspection

#### Legislation

- KCR is a State legislated regime
- New subsidiary legislation will be promulgated
- Provides statutory powers for the Appropriate Authority
- Covers areas such as registration of known consignors and security requirements
- Spells out offences and stipulated penalties for noncompliance



#### Registration & Certification

(For those with Industry-Recognised Security Certification)

- Upon roll out of KCR, consignors will be given 5 months to submit:
  - Application form;
  - ACRA business profile; and
  - Valid industry-recognised security certificate
- Upon approval, a 5-year KC Certificate will be issued to successful applicants after the registration period
  - KC will be assigned with a unique identification number e.g. KC/XXX/YYYY



#### Registration & Certification

(For those with Industry-Recognised Security Certification)

- List of KCs will be published on KCR website (<u>https://www.police.gov.sg/kcr</u>)
- Subject to ad-hoc inspections on a regular basis throughout the 5-year KC certification period
- Process for renewal of KC Certificate kicks in 3 months prior to expiry of KC certification

#### Registration & Certification

(For those <u>without</u> Industry-Recognised Security Certification)

- Upon roll out of KCR, consignors will be given 5 months to submit:
  - Application form;
  - ACRA business profile; and
  - Security Programme
- Upon approval, a 3-year Provisional Certificate will be issued to successful applicants after the registration period
  - KC will be assigned with a unique identification number e.g. KC/XXX/YYYY
- List of KCs will be published on KCR website (<u>https://www.police.gov.sg/kcr</u>)


#### Registration & Certification

(For those <u>without</u> Industry-Recognised Security Certification)

- During the 3-year provisional period, Security Programmes (SPs) will be vetted and ground audits conducted to ensure compliance with SP
- Upon completion of ground audits, KC will be issued with the KC certificate which is valid for 5 years from issuance date



- ✓ this will supersede provisional certificate
- Subject to ad-hoc inspections on a regular basis throughout the 5-year KC certification period
- Process for renewal of KC Certificate kicks in 6 months prior to expiry of KC certification



#### Known Consignor Security Programme (KCSP)


- Consignors without Industry-Recognised Security Certification are required to submit KCSP
  - ✓ Legally binding
- A written document that specifies measures and procedures employed by KCs in respect of exported air cargo
- KCSP can be:
  - Self drafted; or
  - Drafted by accredited Security Consultants
    - Engaged by Consignors
    - Fees/Charges to be borne by Consignors
- All SPs must be vetted and approved by APD

#### **Security Programme Requirements**

- 1) Details of Known Consignor
- 2) Scope of KCSP
- 3) Cargo Security Measures
- 4) Managing Security Measures
- 5) Audit of Security Measures
- 6) Physical Security and Access Control
- 7) Management of Controlled Exports
- 8) Security Personnel and Staff Training
- 9) Third-Party Service Providers
- 10) Measures for Heightened Security Alert
