

LICENSING CONDITIONS FOR OPERATING CRANE / GAME MACHINES AT PREMISES

- 1** The licensee must ensure that no students wearing his or her school uniform or any part of a school uniform, or a school T-shirt, is permitted to play at any of the machines in the licensed premises.
- 2** The machine(s) should be placed within the business premises. The licensee must obtain the approval of the Town Council if the machine(s) is/are to be placed at the common area of HDB premises.
- 3** Except for the items listed below, the licensee must obtain the approval of the Licensing Officer for any other items to be offered as prizes. Approved Items for prizes:
 - (a) Toys
 - (b) Key chains
 - (c) T-shirts
 - (d) Note books
 - (e) Jigsaw puzzles
 - (f) Waist pouches
 - (g) Watches
- 4** The pin-tables are of a type approved by the Licensing Officer.
- 5** No gambling or betting takes place at those premises.
- 6** A sign prohibiting gambling and betting at those premises is displayed at a conspicuous place thereat.
- 7** No person below 16 years of age is permitted to use any of the pin-tables at those premises at any time on any school day except between 6.30p.m. and 11.59p.m.
- 8** The person having control or management of those premises does not provide, or cause or permit to be provided, to change of clothes to any student.
- 9** The licensee must ensure that the public entertainment is not likely to be offensive to any race, religion, ethnicity or nationality or potentially cause disharmony amongst different groups.

Under the Public Entertainments Act, unless expressly exempted, a Public Entertainment License is required for any public entertainment activities held in a place to which the public or any class of the public has access to whether gratuitously or otherwise.
