CRITERIA AND DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR LICENCE TO DEAL IN / MANUFACTURE / REPAIR ARMS

Important Notice

Definition of "Arms" includes firearms, airguns, air-pistols, automatic guns, automatic pistols, and gun or any other kind of gun from which any shot, bullet or other missile can be discharged, or noxious fumes or noxious substance can be emitted.

No Arms (including Airsoft or BB Guns) or any component parts of any Arms shall be imported or exported via parcel post.

Criteria for Grant of Licence

To be eligible for a licence to deal in, manufacture or repair Arms, you must meet the following criteria:

For applicant	 Be A Singaporean or Permanent Resident of Singapore Be At least 21 years old at the time of application One of the following business stakeholders as registered with the Accounting and Corporate Regulatory Authority: A Director - For Companies A Partner - For Partnerships, Limited Partnerships and Limited Liability Partnerships The Sole Proprietor - For Sole Proprietorships
For those directly involved in the handling of Arms (licence applicant, directors/ partners and staff)	 Be a fit and proper person. The criteria and requirements for a person to be considered fit and proper to hold a licence are (but not limited to) whether the relevant person has honesty, integrity, a good reputation, competence and capability. For more details, you may refer to the main menu on Criteria for Grant of Licence. Possess relevant experience and knowledge in handling of Arms.
For company	 Registered with the Registry of Companies and Businesses. Proper and secured facilities for the storage, manufacture or repair of arms and their component parts.

Documents Required

You are required to obtain the following documents before applying for any Arms licence.

- a. A catalogue or brochure showing the type of arms to manufacture or deal in.
- b. Documentary proof showing experience in handling arms.

Submission of documents

Documents must be submitted together with the acknowledgement slip generated by PLUS/ LicenceOne, within 5 working days from the submission of the application.
