

CRITERIA AND DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR LICENCE TO IMPORT / EXPORT / PURCHASE ARMS (BY ORGANISATIONS OR DEALERS)

Important Notice

No Arms (including Airsoft or BB Guns) or any component parts of any Arms shall be imported or exported via parcel post.

Criteria for Grant of Licence

To be eligible for a licence to import, export or purchase Arms you must meet the following criteria:

For applicant	Possess a dealer's licence before you can apply for a licence to import or export Arms. (Note: A licence is not required for transit of arms without offloading in Singapore)
For company	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Arms on transshipment are to remain within the port or airport area• Armed escort is required for conveyance of arms within Singapore• For import, export or transshipment of arms by licensed dealers, the declaration must be made through the TradeNet (including uploading of supporting documents) and the licence fee chargeable shall be deducted from the declarant agent's account to Crimsonlogic

Documents Required

You are required to obtain the following documents before applying for any Arms licence.

- a. A catalogue or brochure showing the type of arms to be imported or exported
- b. Purchase Order or End User Certificate (EUC) from the government department that is making the purchase
- c. EUC and Import permit/ licence from the country of final destination
- d. Bill of Lading or Airway Bill
- e. Invoice from the supplier

Submission of documents

Documents must be submitted together with the acknowledgement slip generated by PLUS/ LicenceOne from the submission of the application.
