

ELIGIBILITY AND DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR LICENCE TO DEAL IN / MANUFACTURE / POSSESS / STORE EXPLOSIVE PRECURSORS

Important Notice

"Explosive Precursor" means any substance specified in the Second Schedule of the Arms and Explosives Act

No Explosive Precursors shall be imported or exported via parcel post.

Criteria for Grant of Licence

To be eligible for a licence to deal in, manufacture, possess or store Explosives Precursors, you must meet the following criteria:

For applicant	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Be A Singaporean or Permanent Resident of Singapore• Be At least 21 years old at the time of application• One of the following business stakeholders as registered with the Accounting and Corporate Regulatory Authority:<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A Director - For Companies• A Partner - For Partnerships, Limited Partnerships and Limited Liability Partnerships• The Sole Proprietor - For Sole Proprietorships
For those directly involved in the handling of Explosives Precursors (licence applicant, directors/ partners and staff)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Be a fit and proper person. The criteria and requirements for a person to be considered fit and proper to hold a licence are (but not limited to) whether the relevant person has honesty, integrity, a good reputation, competence and capability. For more details, you may refer to the main menu on Criteria for Grant of Licence.• Possess relevant experience and knowledge in handling of Explosives Precursors.
For company	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Registered with the Registry of Companies and Businesses.• Proper and secured facilities for the storage of Explosives Precursors

Documents Required

You are required to obtain the following documents before applying the licence.

- A catalogue and safety datasheets of explosive precursors
- Training records and certifications of staff handling explosive precursors;
- Safety and security plan for handling, transportation and storage of explosive precursors (where applicable)
- Write up on the actual processes where explosive precursors are used

Submission of documents

Documents must be submitted together with the acknowledgement slip generated by PLUS/ LicenceOne, within 5 working days from the submission of the application.
