Declaration By Applicant

- 2) I shall maintain a record of this delivery in my database and obtain the signed delivery note from the master of the vessel which shall include the official vessel stamp.
- 3) Prior to departure of the vessel with the items onboard(exporting), I shall request my handling agent to declare the Outward Declaration showing the description and quantities of the consignment using the correct HS and Product Codes through the TradeNet System for GEWD's approval.
- 4) I shall obtain a Strategic Trade Scheme Tier 1 permit via TradeNet® prior to the export/transshipment/bringing in transit* of the items, if they meet the specification of the items listed in the Strategic Goods Control List.
